RSVP Station – Mission Central HUB

The Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) recently partnered with Mission Central HUB located at 1738 N Branch Ave, Altoona, PA 16601. Mission Central HUB is a non-profit organization where sixteen AmeriCorps Senior volunteers assemble four types of kits: baby kits, care kits, activity kits, and cleaning kits. The baby kit includes receiving blankets, undershirts/onesies, washcloths, gowns/sleepers, and a sweater or jacket. The care kit includes a hand towel, a washcloth, a comb, a metal nail file or clipper, bath soap, a toothbrush, bandages, and a gallon sized resealable plastic bag. The activity kit includes scissors, notebooks, a ruler, a handheld pencil sharpener, pencils with erasers. crayons/markers, pens, and a cloth bag to carry them. The cleaning kit includes scouring pads, a scrub brush, cleaning towels, laundry detergent, dish detergent, concentrate cleaner, clothesline, clothespins, dust masks,

latex gloves, heavy duty work gloves, a 5-gallon bucket with lid, garbage bags, insect repellent, and an air freshener. AmeriCorps Senior volunteers also make blankets and quilts for the homeless.

Hope Harrison, Executive Director of Mission Central, wrote a letter to Mission Central HUB that said, "Thank you for your recent in-kind donation of 66 Cleaning Buckets, 760 Activity Kits, 720 Care Kits, and a variety of other needed items! Last year, the Mission Central warehouse assisted 8.7 million people with over \$23.5 million in resources. Thank you for being part of our success, helping us to assist people here in Central Pennsylvania, throughout the United States and around the world."

Mission Central HUB is always looking for volunteers to help sew, knit, or crochet infant sweaters, quilts, infant gowns, activity bags, and homeless blankets.
